


## TEI Answer Directions If Scrolling

They usually have four babies at one time!

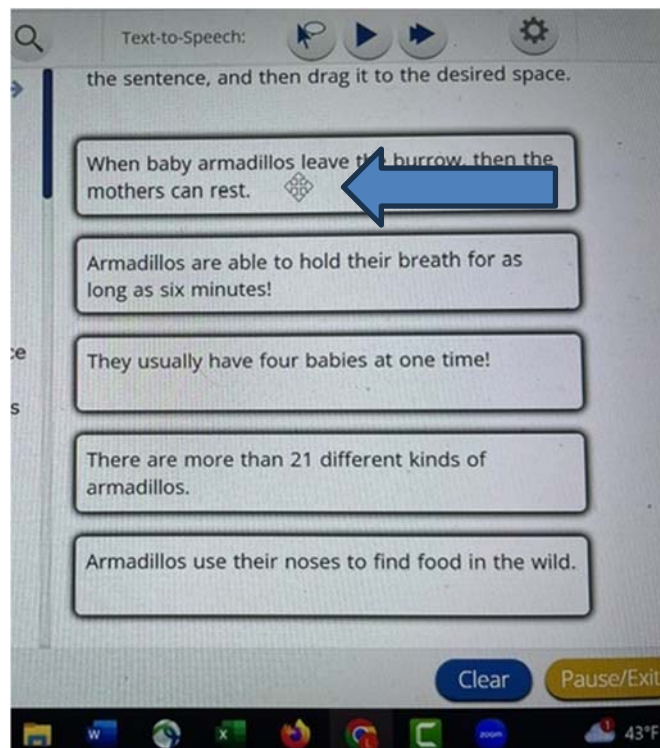
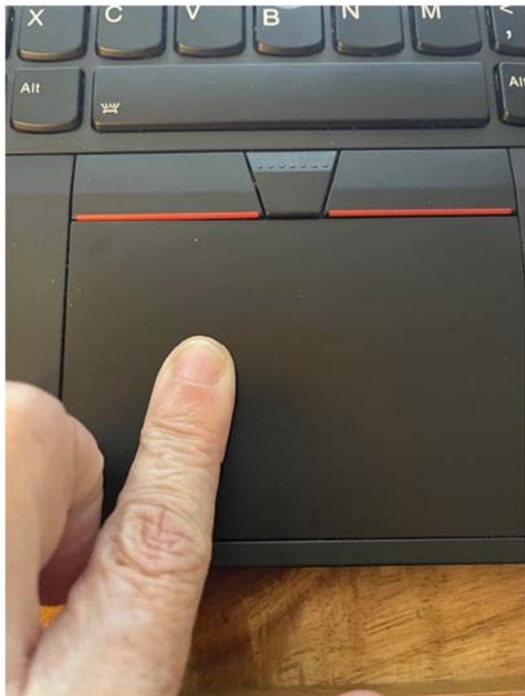

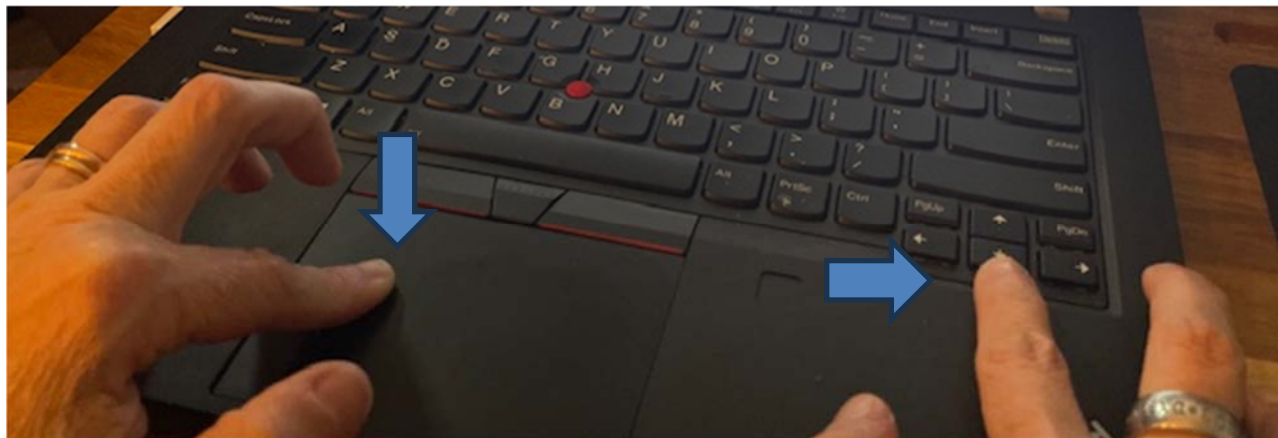
### Step 2a: Using a Trackpad to Answer

Click on the tile/answer you wish to move. Keep your finger held down on the trackpad. You will see the pointer change to a four-pointed star on most devices.



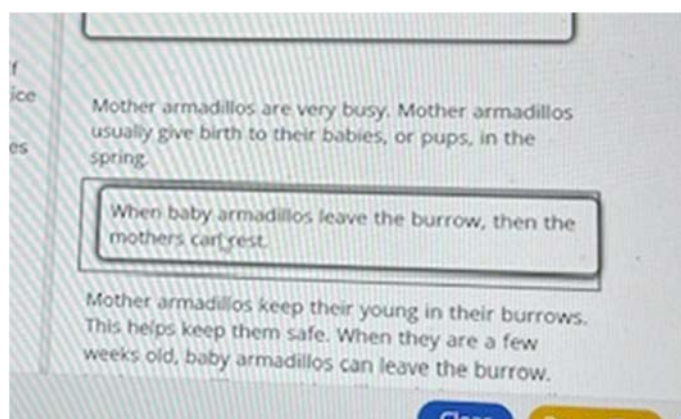
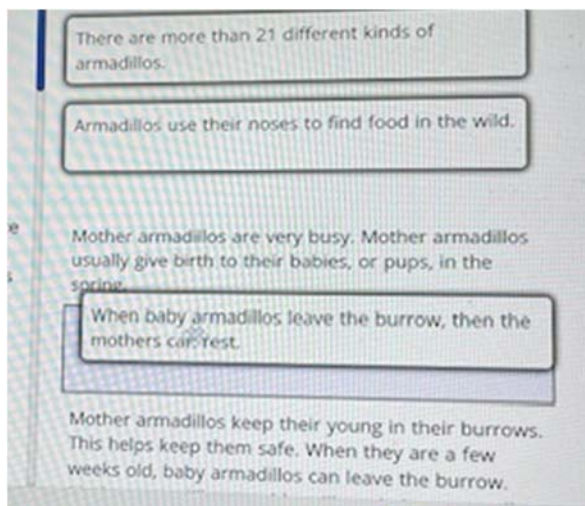
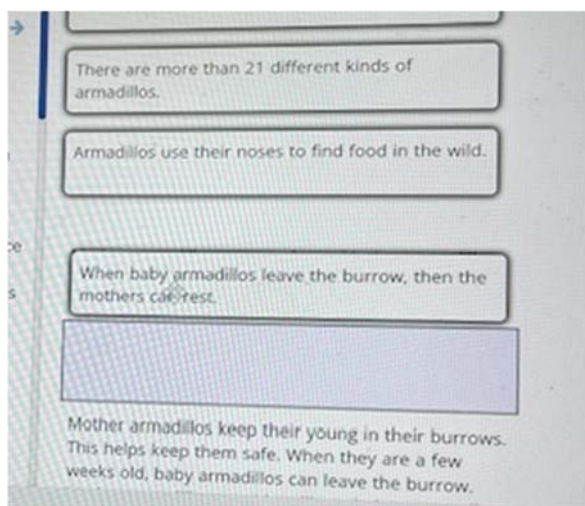
### Step 3a: Using a Trackpad and Down Arrow Key to Answer

Hold down your finger on the trackpad while using your down arrow keyboard key to scroll down the screen and find the open answer space to drop in the tile/answer.



#### Step 4a: Using a Trackpad to Answer

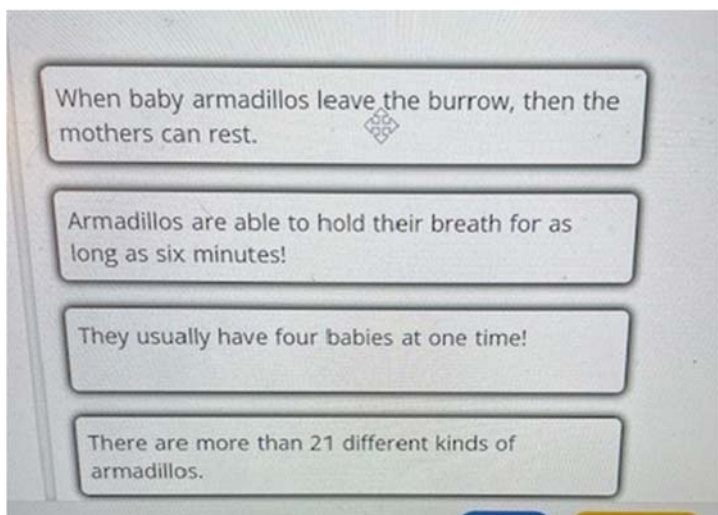
Keep holding down one finger on the trackpad and use another finger on the trackpad to scroll down and position your tile/answer over the goalbox. Remove the finger held down on the trackpad to drop the tile/answer in the goalbox. Use your up-arrow key on the keyboard to scroll back up the screen.



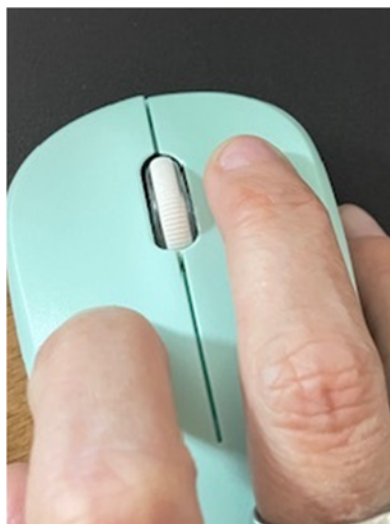
### Step 2b: Using a Mouse to Answer if You Have a Scroll Wheel

If you have a mouse with a left button, a right button, and a scroll wheel in-between you can select the tile/answer with the left button, hold it down and use the wheel to scroll down the page to the goalbox. You must hold down the left-hand side button while you scroll. Once you reach the goalbox you can release all fingers.

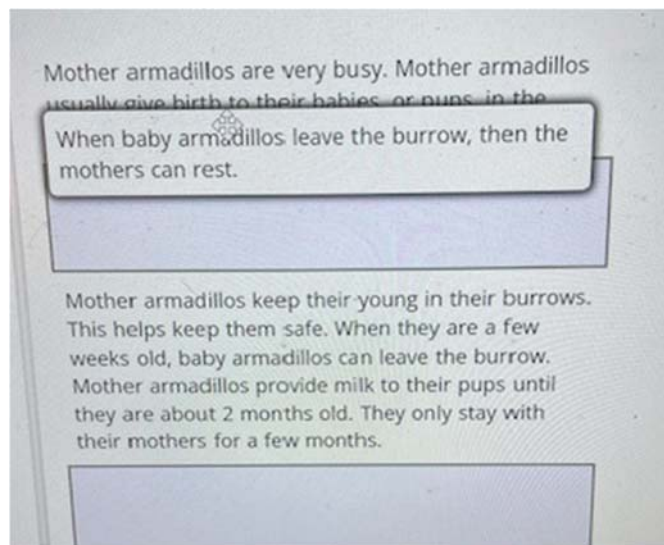
